SAFE MANAGEMENT OF UPROOTED, BROKEN, LEANING AND HUNG-UP TREES

► **Pre-Course Requirements:** To attend this course trainees must already hold a qualification in Chainsaw Maintenance, Cross Cutting and Felling and Processing Medium Trees up to 760mm.

This course is designed to follow course F03. It is for experienced operators wishing to understand the complexities of managing uprooted, broken, leaning and hung-up trees and the operation of the associated equipment including the industrial portable winch.
