ASSISTED FELLING

▶ **Pre-Course Requirements:** To attend this course trainees must already hold a qualification in Chainsaw Maintenance, Cross Cutting and Felling Small Trees up to 380mm.

This course is designed to follow course F01 or F02. It is for operators wishing to understand the implementation of textile and wire rope based assisted felling systems to improve felling accuracy and control.
