USE OF CUTTING TOOLS (INCLUDING CHAINSAWS) FROM A MOBILE ELEVATING WORK PLATFORM (MEWP)

► **Pre-Course Requirements:** To attend this course trainees must already hold a qualification in Chainsaw Maintenance, Cross Cutting and Felling Small Trees up to 380mm. If top-handled chainsaws are to be included in the training then trainees must also hold a qualification in Chainsaw from a Rope and Harness.

This course introduces trainees to the safe use of cutting tools from a MEWP including battery powered and petrol driven chainsaws.
