# USE OF CHAINSAW FROM A ROPE AND HARNESS

► **Pre-Course Requirements:** To attend this course trainees must already hold a qualification in Tree Climbing and Aerial Rescue.

This course is designed to follow on from the F02 and A01 courses. It will provide trainees with the necessary skills to operate a chainsaw from a rope and harness.
